Mission Objective: To establish a secure lunar repository called the Lunaprise in support of Arch Missions Foundation's billion-year archive, preserving human knowledge for eternity. These messages are called Lunagrams and can be submitted online as text, an image, or both. Music and video files are also accepted. An archive from the nonprofit Arch Mission Foundation, including the English Wikipedia, The Rosetta Project, Long Now Foundation content, Project Gutenberg content, and other cultural archive datasets are also included in our payload.

Notable Achievements, Content and Milestones:

- **First-of-Its-Kind Archive**: Created in collaboration with the Arch Mission Foundation, Lunaprise is an indestructible time capsule created to preserve human cultural history for future generations. The Arch Mission Foundation, a notable non-profit, is behind the ambitious Billion-Year Archive project, aimed at safeguarding humanity's legacy across various solar systems & hidden spots on Earth.
- **Marketing Campaign Launch**: Launched in November 2020, the campaign, led by Galactic Legacy Labs, to gain public interest to drive humanity's contributions to the archive and help make history,
- **Curation of Humanity**: In June 2021, Dallas Santana was brought in as an equity partner, named the Executive Curation & Strategy Director and Board Member of Galactic Legacy Labs LLC. Dallas initiated the curation process, inviting notable creators worldwide to submit Lunagrams (multimedia representations of human imagination) to be preserved on the moon, with 10% of net proceeds going to Arch Mission Foundation in support of their billion-year project.

- **Arch Mission Foundation Content**: Includes English Wikipedia, Rosetta Project (all known languages), Project Gutenberg (thousands of books), David Copperfield's Magic Secrets (vault), Arch Lunar Art Archive, Content from Internet Archive, music, images, software, data sets, and other cultural artifacts, plus a Primer that teaches over a million concepts in pictures with connections to 5 languages.

Future Goals:

Expand the lunar archive with additional data and contributions from notable creators through our library called Lunark to support climate change education and Nue Moon to unleash the creator in all of us, respectively. We will tell this story about the TardiGees, a fictional story whose genesis is based on a real life event of when the Tardigrades crashed onto the moon in 2019. Our focus is to foster global participation in the mission, encouraging individuals to send messages to the moon through our next missions planned, named Lunark™ and Nue Mune, respectively, continuing to financially support the Arch Mission's Foundation by connecting to the education system to inspire children that moon shots are real and to remember to reach for the stars.

More About Our Philanthropic Vision:

The Arch Mission Foundation (AMF) is a 501c3 that is backing up human civilization -- like a "global seed vault" for knowledge. We are storing indestructible million and billion-year timescale copies of important data sets -- using ultra-long-term storage media such as nickel films, quartz optical storage, and even storage in synthetic DNA. We store these archives (or "Arks") in redundant locations around planet Earth and across the solar system. AMF has already sent archives on 5 missions to locations in space, with one already on the Moon, one orbiting the Sun, and two more archives to be sent to the Moon in 2024. AMF also stores archives in underground lava tubes, deep mountain bunkers, caves, and other physical locations on Earth. These archives aim to ensure, even in million to billion-year timescales - what we know about the history and our present world - and all the important content we created - will never be lost. This is the first time in history that this has been possible to achieve, and if we are successful, then our civilization will end the cycle of lost civilizations (there have been thousands) and will therefore be the first permanent civilization in our solar system.
